- The paper should be minimum 3 pages;
- The title of the paper should be written in the center in bold on the top lines; below the heading, in the center, write the name, surname (in bold and in open form): author'(s) academic degree and academic title, the name of the country, place of work and study, email address, ORCID number;
- The references should be in APA 7 format;
- All manuscripts will be subjected to blind peer reviewing;
